

The Stickney Bank



The Stickney branch of the Midland Bank was situated in what was Bett's old butchers shop on the opposite side of the Main Road to the Rising Sun public house. It was opened for business in 1959 and a branch directory of the time lists its address as just "Main Road Stickney PE22 8AA".

It was established as a sub-office of the Spilsby branch but it was only ever opened on Fridays from Ten o'clock in the morning, until half past Twelve. The Bank Manager was Mr James Braybrooks who at the time was living in the village. When Mr Harold Johnson became the new Bank Manager at the Midland in Spilsby the Stickney branch was closed down within six months of his appointment.

The office finally closed its doors on 31 October 1975 and all the business from Stickney would have been transferred to the Spilsby Bank. The empty premises that are joined to Oxford House became an Antiques shop afterwards.
